#### **RULES**

- 1. Show will be conducted according to ACS Rules and Regulations, as revised.
- 2. Entries will be received Saturday from 7:00-10:00 A.M. Judging shall begin at 10:30 A.M.
- 3. Only three blooms of any one variety may be entered per class.
- 4. No one bloom may win more than one award.
- 5. Any individual may exhibit. Entries must be from plants owned by and in the possession of the exhibitor for at least 30 days. Exhibitor does not have to be a member of a camellia society or garden club.
- 6. All blooms with multiple names will be exhibited as representatives of one variety. The authority for classification will be the latest edition of the *SCCS No-menclature* or supplement. Where a bloom is classified to include 2 sizes, the smaller size shall be used for awards, except for miniatures.
- 7. Standard Entry Cards should include the name of the variety, the class, and have the bloom size circled.
- 8. Chemically treated blooms will not be separated from untreated blooms.
- 9. The Entry Committee reserves the right to reject blooms of poor quality.
- 10. Unnamed blooms will be identified if possible. If not, they will not be judged except novice class.
- 11. Entries should be in containers provided by the show and have one bloom with no buds and one, but no more than two leaves.
- 12. Blooms entered become the property of the Camellia Show Committee and must remain in place until the close of the show, at which time they will be destroyed for disease prevention.
- 13. If only one variety is entered, it shall constitute a class.
- 14. Only authorized persons shall be allowed in exhibition hall during placement and judging.
- 15. Unprotected blooms are those grown in natural surroundings without any manmade protection.
- 16. Show judges will select outstanding blooms in each class by utilizing "weighted average" scoring.
- 17. A novice is an individual who has never won a "Head Table Award."
- 18. Ribbons will be given in all classes: First Place Blue, Second Place Red, and Third Place Yellow. Judges' decisions are final.
- 19. Monetary awards will be given.
