SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1. Entries (open to all growers) will be received from 8:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. on Saturday morning. All blooms entered must be grown by the exhibitor who must have had the plant in his or her possession at least 30 days prior to the show. Any individual may exhibit their blooms. Exhibitor does not have to be a member of any camellia society. All exhibitors are urged to use proper entry cards and to circle correct sizes of bloom.
- 2. The ACS and the Camellia Club of New Orleans recognizes the "Camellia Nomenclature" published by the Southern California Camellia Society (SCCS) as the official nomenclature publication. To win an ACS Certificate or Award, except for seedlings and sports, the variety MUST be listed in the 1981 "Camellia Nomenclature Historical Edition" the current edition of "Camellia Nomenclature" or the "Camellia Nomenclature Supplement". This includes varieties with errors corrected, registered with the ACS but omitted from the "Camellia Nomenclature", registered with ACS and listed in subsequent issues of the ACS "The Camellia Journal" and "American Camellia Yearbook" and registered with the SCCS subsequent to the publication of the "Camellia Nomenclature". Blooms that are in the "International Camellia Society Registry" will also be eligible as long as the exhibitor provides proof of registration acceptable to the Chairmen of the judges.
- Entries must have only one bloom to a stem and at least one but not more than two leaves; not necessarily attached. Collars may be used to support large blooms. Exhibitors will complete appropriate entry cards. The color of the card indicating the type of bloom:

Grown in Open	White Cards
Grown Protected	Green Cards
Seedlings	Official ACS Pink Cards
Sports	Official ACS Red Cards
Novice Blooms	White Cards with Green Stickers

- 3. All blooms with multiple names must be exhibited under the name accepted by the Southern California Camellia Society's "Camellia Nomenclature". A classification table will be available to assist exhibitors. Blooms entered under improper names not corrected before judging will be disqualified. EXHIBITORS ARE URGED TO USE THE CLASSIFICATION TABLE.
- 4. Classification as to size will be in accordance with the latest edition of "Camellia Nomenclature". Where a bloom is classified to include two sizes, the SMALLER SIZE shall determine the award class with the exception of miniatures. Blooms must be classified as miniatures only, not miniature to small to compete in the Miniature Class. Only JAPONICA miniatures can compete in the Miniature Class.
- 5. Judges are invited and urged to bring blooms for competition but will disqualify themselves while their blooms are being judged.
- 6. During the judging, only judges, clerks and authorized persons will be permitted in the show area.
- 7. No awards or ribbons will be given unless the exhibits are sufficiently meritorious and up to standard. The Show Committee reserves the right to interpret the rules and to make further rules for the proper conduct of the show.
- 8. No bloom can compete in more than one class and may win only one trophy.
- **9.** The Show Committee will provide as much protection as possible but will not assume any responsibility for the loss or damage to any personal property regardless of cause.

10.ALL BLOOMS WILL BE HELD BY THE CAMELLIA CLUB OF NEW ORLEANS, INC. FOR DEPOSITION AFTER THE SHOW. This precaution is necessary due to the spread of petal blight.
