Warren has served on the board of both ACS and ACCS.

They also support the three MGCS Shows each season, Warren as judges chairman and Cheryl as clerks chairperson.

They have also served the ACCS as the Historian, taking numerous pictures of our meetings and annual convention, as well as the keepers of the Scrapbook.

Warren also received the prestigious Joseph H. Pyron Award in 2009 for outstanding service to ACS.

Warren was postmaster in Ft. Valley when the United States 18 cent stamp, honoring the C. Japonica “Betty Sheffield Supreme” with the First Day of Issue Ceremonies on April 23, 1981 at Ft. Valley and the American Camellia Society.

Milton Brown was Executive Director of the ACS at the time and leaned heavily on Warren to have a reception at his house. Warren was expecting approximately 25 to 30 people, which actually turned out to be 70 plus. That’s when

Warren’s interest in Camellias caught fire.

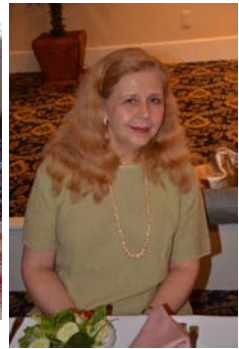

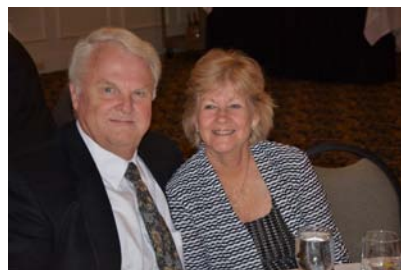

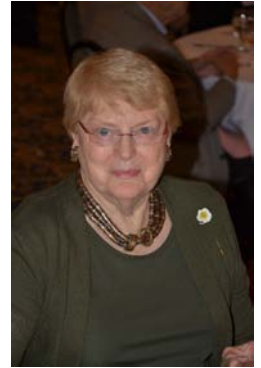
